By 2026, Bangladesh's commercial vehicle market has roared past its \$2.5 billion base from 2020, accelerating at 8–10% annually as booming logistics, construction, and infrastructure projects fuel soaring demand for trucks, buses, and light commercial vehicles—making it one of the fastest-expanding and most dynamic segments of the nation's automotive industry.
2. Bangladesh's bus segment is powering ahead on a steady growth trajectory, projected to expand at just over 4% annually between 2023 and 2027, with market volume nearing US \$30 million by 2027—driven by surging urban mobility needs, expanding public transport networks, and bold government investment in infrastructure that is reshaping the nation's transit landscape.
3. Dhaka's bus fleet has seen dramatic swings in recent years—rising from 1,213 units in 2021 to 2,233 in 2022, before dipping to 1,887 in 2023 and then rebounding again in 2024—yet the overall trajectory points upward, with projections through 2026 showing continued expansion as booming urban mobility needs, expanding public transport networks, and sustained government investment drive the capital toward a more connected, efficient, and future-ready transit system.
4. The Dhaka Commercial Automotive Show 2026, the oldest and largest exhibition of its kind in Bangladesh, has powered the nation's commercial automotive industry for nearly a decade—evolving into a premier platform that unites leading manufacturers, suppliers, and industry

stakeholders under one roof to showcase cutting-edge innovation, forge powerful partnerships, and drive the future of mobility.

5. The Padma Bridge, a landmark structure, is unleashing massive economic ripple effects across Bangladesh—opening new trade routes, logistics hubs, and transport networks that are reshaping national connectivity while fueling unprecedented growth in the commercial automotive industry, positioning it as a powerhouse of mobility and economic transformation.

6. Bangladesh imported over 35,000 commercial vehicles in 2020, primarily from India, Japan, and China, and by 2026 soaring demand for trucks, buses, and light vehicles underscores both the nation’s reliance on global suppliers and the powerful new opportunities emerging for local assembly and parts manufacturing—driving a bold transformation in the country’s commercial automotive landscape.

7. 

## WHY BANGLADESH? FACTS & FIGURES

According to Bangladesh Road Transport Authority for almost a decade the market for commercial vehicles has grown at a rate of 14% to 20% each year until 2020. Now it is expected to be even more. Bangladesh is a potential market for commercial vehicles as the nation is currently involved in many Mega Infrastructure Projects. The Padma Bridge - which was a 30,193 crore BDT project - is predicted to create demand for thousands of commercial vehicles worth at least \$500 million for at least the next five years. The Buses segment in Bangladesh is projected to grow by 4.07% (2023-2027) resulting in a market volume of US\$29.32m in 2027. Thus with the rising demand Bangladesh is one of the best places to invest in and reap benefits while new players still have a chance to enter the market.
