Cost-Effective Production with Skilled Labor: Bangladesh offers a unique combination of low production costs and skilled labor, enabling manufacturers to achieve both efficiency and quality. The country's workforce is experienced in handling large-scale production, ensuring timely delivery of bulk orders for global supply chains.





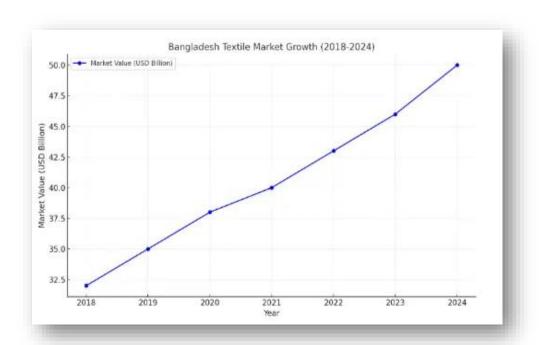
Sustainability Leadership: Bangladesh is setting a benchmark in green and sustainable manufacturing, with over 200 LEED-certified factories and a growing emphasis on ecofriendly production. Partnering with Bangladesh enables manufacturers to align with global sustainability goals and meet increasing consumer demand for ethical and responsible fashion.

Leading Economy in South Asia: Leading Economy in South Asia:Bangladesh's GDP—propelled by a surge in garment exports to approximately \$55 billion—is forecasted to reach around \$610 billion, securing its position as the world's 32nd largest economy. Meanwhile, under Purchasing Power Parity (PPP), the scale expands to \$2.18 trillion, elevating it to the 25th global rank and surpassing regional peers like Singapore (\$520–540 billion), Malaysia (\$450–470 billion), and Vietnam (\$560–580 billion). This trajectory not only underscores Bangladesh's export-driven resilience but also signals a maturing economy poised for sustained middle-income status.

Why Bangladesh - Facts & Figures

Strategic Market Access: Located at the crossroads of Asia, Bangladesh provides strategic access to key markets in Europe, North America, and Asia. The country's robust trade agreements and preferential tariffs with major markets offer global manufacturers a competitive edge in reducing costs and expanding their reach.

By focusing on Bangladesh, global manufacturers can tap into a thriving market with unparalleled growth potential, sustainability initiatives, and a proven track record in global apparel supply chains.





In Figures

Bangladesh's textile and garment machinery market is valued at over US \$4 billion, according to industry reports, and has been growing at an annual rate of nearly 20% due to continuous modernization and capacity expansion. A major driver of this growth is the sector's transition toward man-made fibre (MMF)-based production, which is increasing demand for advanced machinery. Alongside this, the government and private sector are gradually adopting automation and smart manufacturing technologies, although the exact share of Industry 4.0 investments is not yet quantified. Beyond machinery, Bangladesh's overall textile manufacturing market is estimated at around US \$39.5 billion in 2025, projected to reach US \$52.3 billion by 2030.

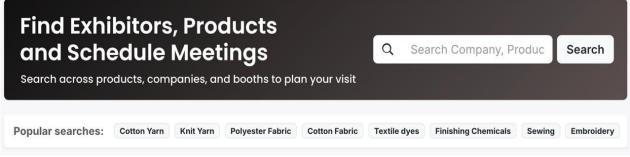
