A series of international exhibitions on food, agriculture, healthcare, pharmaceuticals and medical tourism, organised by CEMS-Global, began at the International Convention City Bashundhara (ICCB) in the capital on Thursday.

The exhibitions will continue until Saturday and remain open daily from 10am to 7pm.

CEMS-Global (USA and Asia Pacific) President and Group Managing Director Meherun N Islam chaired the inaugural ceremony.

Bangladesh's coffee industry showcased at Food Expo

ENTREPRENEURS, farmers and cafe owners are showcasing coffee products and business opportunities at the 9th Food Bangladesh International Expo 2026 at the International Convention City Bashundhara in Kuril area of the capital.

The three-day expo, organised by CEMS-Global USA in association with CEMS Bangladesh, will continue until May 9 and remain open daily from 10:00am to 7:00pm.

A major attraction at this year's expo is Coffee Fest, where local coffee growers, equipment suppliers and cafe

brands are presenting Bangladesh's growing coffee culture and industry potential.

Mohammad Sazzad Hossain Tulip, founder and CEO of Tulip Coffee Farming and Roastery, has been working to promote locally cultivated coffee.

Tulip told New Age that his journey into coffee farming began during a visit to Bandarban while he was still employed in the private sector. There, he discovered that indigenous communities had been cultivating coffee plants for years.

Inspired by the experience, he collected coffee seedlings and started experimental cultivation in Nali-

tabari of Sherpur district.

"What started as a small experiment gradually turned into a serious venture," he said. "I realised Bangladesh imports almost all of its coffee from countries like Brazil, Ethiopia, Vietnam and Italy, despite having suitable land and weather for cultivation."

As coffee demand surged in cafes nationwide, Tulip increased production by giving farmers free seedlings and creating a local supply chain.

Today, around 250 to 300 farmers across Bangladesh are linked to his network, cultivating coffee on an estimated 300 to 400 acres of land.

"Some farmers have five acres, some two acres and some even half an acre," he said. "I collect the harvest, process the beans, roast them and supply them to the local market."

According to him, demand for locally produced coffee has increased significantly, with most of this year's production already sold out.

"Many customers who once relied on imported coffee are now choosing Bangladeshi coffee instead," he added.

Tulip also said international experts from the Netherlands recently visited his farms and expressed surprise at the quality of Bangladeshi coffee after testing samples in Europe.

"They advised me to focus on the domestic market first because the local demand itself has huge potential," he said.

He believes Bangladesh

could meet a large share of its coffee demand in the future if five to seven lakh coffee trees are planted nationwide.

Another notable figure at the expo is Samath Bin Salam, the founder of Coffee Fest and owner of Smith's, a company that supplies coffee-making equipment, including coffee machines, coffee grinders, automatic coffee machines, roasting machines, and accessories.

He said Coffee Fest was launched to create a proper platform for Bangladesh's coffee community, which previously lacked an organised industry event despite coffee being one of the world's most traded commodities.

"When we started three years ago, there were a few participating companies," he said. "Now nearly 30 brands and businesses are part of the

festival."

According to him, the festival showcases the entire coffee ecosystem, from farming and harvesting to roasting equipment, cafe operations and retail businesses.

"We wanted people to experience the full journey of coffee under one roof," he said.

He believes Bangladesh has strong long-term market potential due to its large population and the rapid growth of cafe culture, especially among young consumers.

The expo has also attracted regional cafe brands looking to expand beyond their cities.

One such participant is Coffeeta Shop, a cafe brand from Khulna that started operations in 2019.

Operations manager Ehsan said the business initially served affordable instant coffee before gradually shifting to international-standard coffee products after the pandemic.
