This sharp rise underscores the sector's accelerating momentum, driven by booming domestic demand, expanding export markets, and strong government support—cementing Bangladesh's position as one of Asia's most dynamic pharmaceutical hubs.

5. By 2026, Bangladesh's government is driving a bold API manufacturing push through export incentives and tax breaks. Anchored in the 2018 API Policy, the initiative aims to cut import reliance to 80% by 2032, attract USD 1 billion in investment, boost export revenues, and create 500,000 new jobs. With the establishment of a dedicated API Park, Bangladesh is positioning itself as a competitive regional hub for pharmaceutical raw materials and a magnet for global investors.

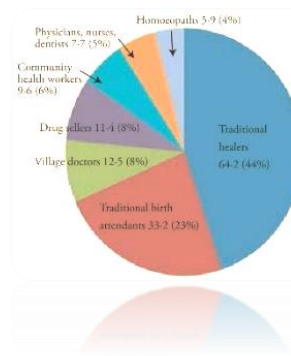
WHY BANGLADESH

By 2026, Bangladesh has firmly positioned itself as one of Asia's fastest-growing pharmaceutical and medical device markets. The pharmaceutical industry now meets nearly 98% of domestic demand, with the market size surpassing USD 6 billion, while exports continue to expand to more than 150 countries, including highly regulated destinations such as the US and Europe. Between July 2024 and February 2025 alone, pharmaceutical exports generated USD 134.15 million, marking a 13% year-on-year rise, and this momentum has carried forward into 2026. The medical device sector, valued at USD 442 million in 2021, has flourished at a 13% annual growth rate, crossing USD 800 million by 2025 and continuing its upward trajectory. Imports of medical devices are growing at a CAGR of around 10%—significantly higher than the global industry average of 4–6%—underscoring the country's strong healthcare demand and modernization drive. With generics maintaining over 85% market share, government initiatives such as

the API policy 2018 and the establishment of a dedicated API Park are attracting USD 1 billion in planned investment by 2032, aiming to reduce import reliance and create 500,000 new jobs. These figures highlight why Bangladesh is not only self-sufficient in pharmaceuticals but also a rising global hub, making it the ideal host for international exhibitions that bring together innovators, investors, and industry leaders to tap into one of the most dynamic healthcare markets in Asia.

IN FIGURES

By 2026, Bangladesh's pharmaceutical industry has firmly established itself as a global growth engine, meeting nearly 98% of domestic demand with a market size exceeding USD 6 billion, while exports to more than 150 countries continue to rise, including breakthroughs in highly regulated markets like the US and Europe. Pharmaceutical exports have grown steadily, medical device imports are expanding at a 10% CAGR—well above the global average of 4–6%—and government initiatives such as the API Policy and the creation of a dedicated API Park are driving investment, reducing import reliance, and boosting local production. With generics maintaining over 85% market share, strong policy support, and Asia's API market projected to grow at 9% CAGR until 2027, Bangladesh is strategically positioned as one of the fastest-growing pharmaceutical hubs in Asia, offering unmatched opportunities for investors and global partners..
